



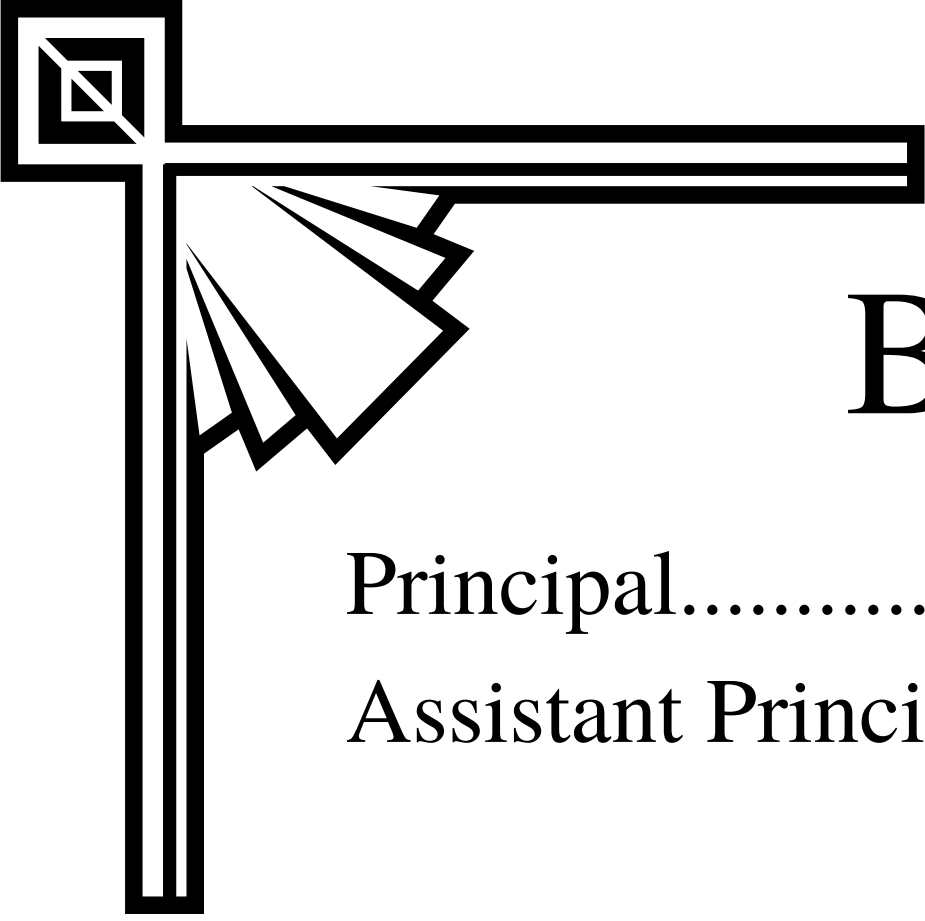

## Director's Note

William Shakespeare's Twelfth Night is a classic romantic comedy focusing on the trials that love can bring. In the play, Viola enters Illyria in search of her brother, only to discover she has been deemed an outsider. Working with the coatman, she disguises herself as a servant of the Duke Orsino. In her new disguise, she finds herself trapped in a classic love triangle between herself, the man she loves, and the fair Lady Olivia. Alongside the trio's story comes another tale of trickery as Toby, Maria, Feste, and Sir Andrew write a letter to Malvolio pretending to be the one he dotes on: The Lady Olivia. As we learned the story of Twelfth Night students began to voice their connections to the story and how moments, characters, or emotions reflected what they were going through in their lives. As we continued to make connections, the students began to see how Shakespeare's play could easily reflect any given moment in time. Whether it was a story in the 1600's, the 1920's, or present day 2022, the tendencies of humanity still ring true in William Shakespeare's Twelfth Night.
